ONLINE ADMINISTRATION POLICY

1. Purpose of the Online SRE

The Student Readiness Evaluation (SRE) is conducted online to ensure:

- Standardised administration across institutions
- Equal opportunity access for all students

2. Voluntary Participation & Informed Consent

- Personal data will not be sold or used for unrelated marketing purposes.
- Data storage follows secure digital practices.

Institutions receive:

- Not individual public ranking.

4. No Ranking / No Labeling Policy

The SRE:

- Does not rank students
- Does not classify students as “good” or “poor”
- Does not affect academic grades

It only:

- Identifies orientation patterns
- Suggests suitable pathways

- Creates measurable baseline benchmarks

5. Fair Administration Guidelines

To ensure integrity:

- The SRE should be completed individually
- No discussion during response submission
- Estimated completion time: **45 Minutes**
- Students must respond honestly
- No external assistance should be used

6. Interpretation Transparency

Students may request:

- Their individual readiness profile
- Explanation of pathway recommendation
- Institutions receive:
 - Structured summary dashboards
 - Cohort-level segmentation report

7. Ethical Use of Results

SRE results shall be used only for:

- Pathway segmentation
- Mentoring alignment
- Programme planning
- Institutional readiness analysis

Results shall not be used for:

- Admission rejection
- Academic penalisation
- Public comparison
